



Jack A. Wilson Engineering Scholarship Fund

The Jack A. Wilson Engineering Scholarship Fund was established in December of 2001 by Ms. Gertrude A. Wilson through the Gulf Coast Community Foundation to honor Mr. Wilson.

The purpose of this Fund is to provide scholarships for College, Junior College or Graduate school students entering their third or more year of engineering education. Students must be residents of Jackson, Harrison and Hancock Counties. Students meeting the criteria will be awarded a scholarship to be used toward the following, in order of priority: tuition and fees, room and board, books and supplies

CRITERIA

In making its decision, the Selection Committee will use the following criteria:

- Enrolled in a College, Junior College or Graduate School
- Jackson, Harrison or Hancock County Resident
- Scholarship ability
- Good Academic Standing

GUIDELINES

- Completed Application Form
- Official College Transcript including standardized test scores
- A.C.T. and/or S.A.T. Scores
- Three letters of recommendation from one professor, one community leader and one individual other than a family member
