ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Use this checklist as a self-evaluation tool to strengthen your grant proposal. Proposals that do not meet the criteria below may have a reduced chance of being funded.

Check each box that applies to your grant proposal:

- ☐ **Is NOT** to cover general operating expenses, overhead, interim, or bridge funding
- ☐ **Is NOT** for debt reduction or operational deficits
- ☐ **Is NOT** for endowment funding
- ☐ **Is NOT** a grant to an individual
- ☐ **Is NOT** for capital improvement or renovations to a property that your organization does not own or have at least a five-year lease or written agreement
- ☐ **Does NOT** support partisan, legislative, or political activity
- ☐ **Does NOT** request funding to pay a grant writer
- ☐ **Is NOT** a project of an individual church, religious organization, or body of worship for its own benefit
- ☐ **Does NOT** require participation in faith-based activities to receive benefits of the grant
- ☐ **Is** for a project which will be implemented in and serve primarily residents of the six-county area (George, Hancock, Harrison, Jackson, Pearl River, Stone)
- ☐ **Can** expend all funds within 12 months and within the six-county area
