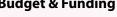
| Is NOT to cover general operating expenses, overhead, interim, or bridge funding   |

| Is NOT a project of an individual church, religious organization, or body of worship for its own benefit   |
| <b>Does NOT</b> require participation in faith-based activities to receive benefits of the grant   |
| <b>Is</b> for a project which will be implemented in and serve primarily residents of the six-county area (George, Hancock, Harrison, Jackson, Pearl River, Stone) |
| Can expend all funds within 12 months and within the six-county area   |
